Tweed-New Haven Airport to Host Career Fair on Friday

The airport and its partners now accepting applications for more than 100 new positions

WHAT: On Friday morning, Tweed-New Haven Airport (HVN) will host a career fair with local partners to share information about more than 100 specific job opportunities based at the airport. The job openings stem from plans announced earlier this year to invest \$100 million in HVN to extend the runway and build a new, carbon neutral terminal, allowing for more flights to more destinations and eliminating the need for existing state and city subsidies.

The career fair is open to the public and free parking will be available. On-site interviews and virtual interviews will be scheduled and conducted. The event will take place outdoors, and will also ask attendees to abide by social distancing and face-covering safety measures.
